### **Job Description:**

They will also assist the department in multiple areas as required (e.g. pitchside cover, delivery of pre/rehabilitation, athlete screening, movement health).

**In-short** the duties of the Senior Sports Therapist/Rehabilitator & Medical Administrator are split into two parts:

## Clinical:

- Soft-tissue lead for 1st team
- Recruit, manage and upskill volunteer soft-tissue therapists
- Manage Student Sports Rehabilitation Intern
- Manage morning screening system
- Provide pitchside training cover as required
- Assist with the delivery of rehab/prehab sessions as required
- Oversee the status of on-loan players
- Lead on the management of concussion GRTPs (alongside HoM and Club Doctor)

#### **Medical Administration:**

- Maintain Injury Surveillance and Availability Records (internal and RFL)
- Manage the filing of clinical letters/MRI reports/Op notes
- Lead on Department Clinic Notes Compliance
- Medical Stock Management/Ordering
- Medical Equipment maintenance (MME and pitchside supplies)
- Arrange Clinical Appointments
- Manage Player Equipment Loans
- Oversee the Player Passport System
- Oversee Baseline Screening (e.g. Concussion and Cardiac Screening)
